



## *It's a new year and I have a new initiative.*

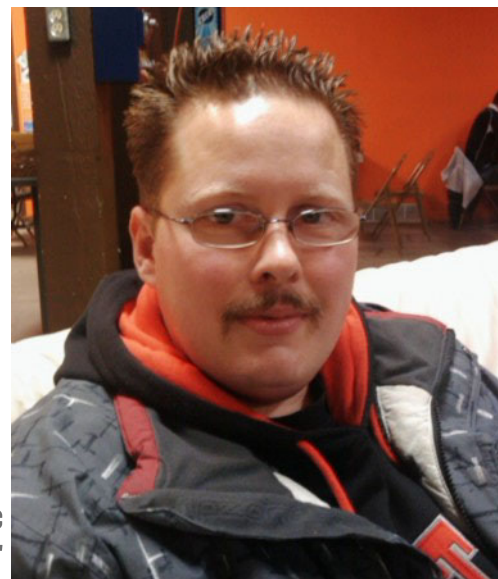

I can only reach a certain amount of youth, but as I enable others to do ministry, the numbers of youth that are reached with the ministry of Jesus' love is multiplied exponentially. There are 8 volunteer leaders that I am intentionally investing in over the next few months. I believe that their impact on the lives of youth can be increased and I'm going to give them the tools, confidence and help to do so.
